Graduation Criteria

1. Eligibility for Graduation

To be eligible for graduation, learners must fulfill the following criteria:

- 1) Achieve a minimum of 80% attendance, unless exceptions are granted by the school administration for valid reasons.
- 2) Demonstrate satisfactory academic progress and meet the learning outcomes as specified in the school curriculum.
- 3) Actively participate in all mandatory student development activities and meet the assessment criteria set by the institution.
- 4) Comply with all school policies, rules, and administrative requirements as determined by the school administration.

2. Academic Results

Learners must meet the following academic results to qualify for graduation:

1) Primary level (Year 1-6)

- Pass the basic subject and the additional courses learning outcomes minimum grade 1.1.
- Students with a grade under 1.1 will need to be re-assessed and/or given an assignment.
- Participate in student development activities.

2) Secondary level (Year 7-9)

- Pass the basic subject and the additional courses learning outcomes minimum grade 1.1
- Students with a grade under 1.1 will need to be re-assessed and/or given an assignment.
- Participate in student development activities.

3) IGCSE level (Year 10-11)

- Pass assessments in at least five subjects, including English and Mathematics.
- Achieve grades ranging from A to G (or 9-1 scale).
- Students with a grade under G will need to be re-assessed and/or given an assignment.
